Definition of Sustaining Membership:

Sustaining Membership. Any natural person, corporation, partnership, association, trust or other entity or organization may be a Sustaining Member of the Corporation so long as the party considered for sustaining membership endorses the purposes of the Corporation as set forth in Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation. Each application for sustaining membership shall be considered and acted upon pursuant to the procedures set forth in section 9.01 of the Bylaws. Sustaining Members shall not be considered “members” as that term is defined in the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act and shall have only those rights and obligations that are specifically set forth in these Bylaws. Sustaining Members shall not be entitled to vote on any matters presented to the members by the Board of Directors. Sustaining membership shall not confer any property rights in the Corporation to the Sustaining Member.
